

No Man Knows the Day or the Hour

**“But of that day and hour no one knows,
not even the angels of heaven, nor the
Son, but the Father alone.”
(Matthew 24:36)**

Argument:

A post-tribulational rapture is impossible because all we would have to do is count from the Abomination of Desolation to the end and we would know the exact day.

**So, how many days would we have to
count?**

“Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for forty-two months.”

(Revelation 11:2)

One literal year = 365 days

One literal month = 30.416 days

42 literal months = 1277.5 days

“Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for 1260 days.”

(Revelation 12:6)

One prophetic year = 360 days

One prophetic month = 30 days

42 prophetic months = 1260 days

“And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate.”

(Daniel 9:27)

1 year = 365 days

7 years = 2555 days

3.5 years = 1277.5 days

(Daniel 12:11)**
