### No Man Knows the Day or the Hour

"But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone."

(Matthew 24:36)

#### Argument:

A post-tribulational rapture is impossible because all we would have to do is count from the Abomination of Desolation to the end and we would know the exact day.

### So, how many days would we have to count?

"Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for forty-two months."

(Revelation 11:2)

One literal year = 365 days
One literal month = 30.416 days
42 literal months = 1277.5 days

"Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for 1260 days."

(Revelation 12:6)

One prophetic year = 360 days
One prophetic month = 30 days
42 prophetic months = 1260 days

"And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate." (Daniel 9:27)

1 year = 365 days 7 years = 2555 days 3.5 years = 1277.5 days "From the time that the regular sacrifice is abolished and the abomination of desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days.

(Daniel 12:11)
