God is Light

- "This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all." (1 John 1:5)
- "The Lord wraps Himself in light as with a garment; He stretches out the heavens like a tent." (Psalm 104:2)
- "The sun shall be no more your light by day, nor for brightness shall the moon give you light; but the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory. Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; for the Lord will be your everlasting *light*, and your days of mourning shall be ended." (Isaiah 60:19-20)





And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, *having the glory of God*. Her brilliance was like a very costly stone, as a stone of crystal-clear jasper. It had a great and high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels; and names were written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel. There were three gates on the east and three gates on the north and three gates on the south and three gates on the west. And the wall of the city had twelve foundation stones, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. The one who spoke with me had a gold measuring rod to measure the city, and its gates and its wall. (**Revelation 21:10–15**)

The city is laid out as a square, and its length is as great as the width; and he measured the city with the rod, fifteen hundred miles; its length and width and height are equal. And he measured its wall, seventy-two yards, according to human measurements, which are also angelic measurements. The material of the wall was jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass. The foundation stones of the city wall were adorned with every kind of precious stone. The first foundation stone was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, chalcedony; the fourth, emerald; the fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, topaz; the tenth, chrysoprase; the eleventh, jacinth; the twelfth, amethyst. And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; each one of the gates was a single pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass. I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp is the Lamb. The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it. In the daytime (for there will be no night there) its gates will never be closed; and they will bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it; and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life. (**Revelation 21:16–27**)










"And night will be no more. *They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light*, and they will reign forever and ever." (Revelation 22:5)

- Most light forms are rather chaotic with wildly variable wavelengths.




Laser photons and their wavelengths however, are not chaotic, raher they are consistent, far more "straight."


Coherent Light: Light that is made up of photons that are all the same wavelength and are in phase is called "coherent light."

(1) The same wavelength,(2) The same amplitude, or height,(3) Are straight.









Polarized Filters
